ARGENTINA

with a main-land area of 1,073,500 square miles, is the eight-largest country in the world!

The name Argentina comes from the Latin word for silver, Argentum. Original European settlers believed the country was full of silver.

BRAZIL

occupies 47.3% of South America, it is the fifth-largest country in the world.

In 2016 Rio de Janeiro was the first South American country to host an Olympic Games. Team USA earned team silver in show jumping!

CANADA

with the world's largest coastline, is the second-largest country in the world.

A phenomenon discovered in the 1960's... there are large parts of Canada that have less gravity than the rest of the Earth.

EL SALVADOR

is known as the "Land of the Volcanoes" because of the more than 20 volcanoes in the territory. Two of them are currently active!

El Salvador is the smallest country in Central America and is the only one without a Caribbean coastline.

GREAT BRITAIN

is smaller than Oregon and has the world's shortest scheduled airline flight lasting just two minutes. It connects the two islands in the UK.

IRELAND

lacks many species of animals that are common elsewhere in Europe due to its isolation from the mainland.

The Irish surname prefix "Mac" means "son of," while "O" means "descendant of."

U.S.A.

is the 4th largest country in the world by land area and the 3rd largest by population.

Alaska is the largest state at 429 times larger than the smallest state, Rhode Island. However, Alaska's population is significantly smaller than Rhode Island's.

VENEZUELA

ranks 7th in the world's list of nations with the most number of species.

Venezuela's name comes from the Italian word "Venezia" (little Venice). Explorer Vespucci saw native stilt houses built in Lake Maracaibo, reminding him of Venice.
